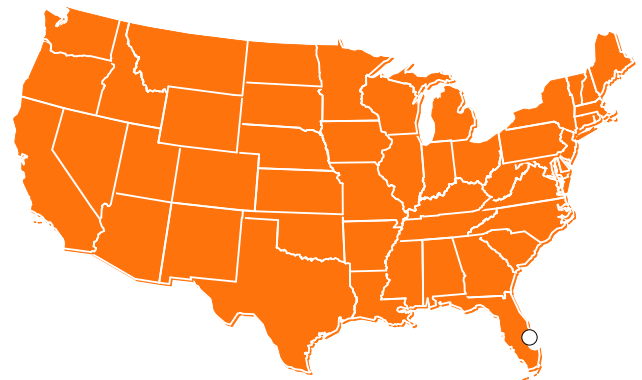


ABOUT THE CENTRE

- Known as “The Venice of America”, Fort Lauderdale has hundreds of miles of beautiful canals lined with elegant boats and watercraft.
- Our centre is located in the heart of town, situated in Fort Lauderdale’s lively Riverfront District.
- Free wireless internet access, a large computer lab, and a comfortable, spacious student lounge.
- 1 full-day and 2-half day excursions per week.
- Easy access to the residences by public transportation.
- 2-minute walk to the nearest bus stop.

ACCOMMODATION

- Residence located in prime location just across the street from the beach.
- All rooms are shared and have air conditioning and private bathrooms.
- A refrigerator, coffee maker, and an iron can be found in each room.
- Features an outdoor swimming pool and lounge area.

FACILITIES

- **Sports activities:** Beach volleyball, soccer, frisbee, etc. All sports activities are held on the beach.
- **Common areas:** Spacious student lounge and a computer lab available to Embassy students.
- **Shops:** Stores, restaurants and cafes are within walking distance of the school.

EVENING ACTIVITY PROGRAMME

We offer a complete activity schedule for the afternoon, leaving most evenings with free time to enjoy the swimming pool at the residence, go shopping or just walk along the seafront; we also organize BBQs and disco nights.

INCLUDED EXCURSIONS

Programme includes:

- All full-day excursions are normally provided by a private transportation company; a travel card can be purchased to visit local attractions.

MEAL PLAN

American food has become much more cosmopolitan and varied. The centre does not have a cafeteria but there are numerous places to eat near the school. Sample Menu:

BREAKFAST

- Breakfast will generally feature milk, juice, fruit, bagels, assorted cereals, cinnamon buns, donuts, tea and coffee

LUNCH

- Lunch is provided at a dining hall near the school where students can go after class. Students will be able to choose from a variety of salads, sandwiches and wraps. Soft drinks and dessert are also included.

DINNER

- Dinner will be catered to the student residence or off-site on occasion. The meal usually includes a salad or soup, an entrée, a dessert and a drink.

- Breakfast: 07.00 – 08.00
- Lunch: 12.30 – 13.30
- Dinner: 18.30 – 19.30

PACKED LUNCHES

During the weekends (on full-day excursions) packed lunches are provided (sample):

PRACTICAL INFORMATION

TRANSFERS TO/FROM CENTRE

- Ft Lauderdale Int'l Airport 20 minutes
- Miami Int'l Airport 1 Hour

Upon arrival at the airport, students will be met by the school's driver holding an Embassy sign with the name of the student or group. The transfer company will take the student to the Fort Lauderdale Residence or Homestay.

LIVING ON CAMPUS

- **LAUNDRY** can be done in coin operated machines at the residence. The cost is \$1.50 per wash and \$1.50 per dry. Group leaders are expected to assist their students with their laundry. Individuals will be given assistance by a member of the Embassy CES staff where required.
- **CLEANING** Common rooms and bathrooms are cleaned three times a week. Students are responsible for keeping their rooms neat. Linens and towels are changed weekly.
- **TOWELS** are provided. Students must bring their own toiletries.
- **A SAFE** is available in the Resident Assistant rooms and at the school. Safes can be made available to group leaders as well.
- **FIRE DRILLS** take place on a regular basis and an **Incident File** is kept on site for any incidents that may arise during the summer.
- **DAMAGES** must be paid for. All rooms and common areas are regularly checked for damages, and individuals who cause damage to any property on the site will be liable for the cost of repairs. **Damage/ Key Deposits** of \$100 (CASH ONLY) are payable by all students on arrival at the centre. This money will be returned at the end of their stay subject to any damages caused.
- **SECURITY** There is 24-hour security on site. Anyone with an emergency during the night should call the centre mobile number which will be given to all students on arrival.
- **DRUGS** Buying, selling, or using drugs is a federal offense and is prohibited. Students violating this policy will be expelled from the residence and from their Embassy CES programme.
- **SMOKING AND ALCOHOL** Smoking is permitted ONLY OUTSIDE the buildings. It is prohibited to smoke in the rooms. No one under the age of 21 should be in possession of alcohol. Violation of this policy could result in your expulsion from the residence and from Embassy Summer.

MEDICAL INFORMATION

If a student is sick and needs medical attention, an Embassy CES staff member will help in making appointments etc. Please note, however that it is not customary for a doctor to visit the centre directly and any trips made to the doctor, dentist or hospital will have to be paid for by the student (including transportation where necessary). Students with a group leader must be accompanied by the group leader. Individual students will be accompanied by an Embassy CES staff member.
