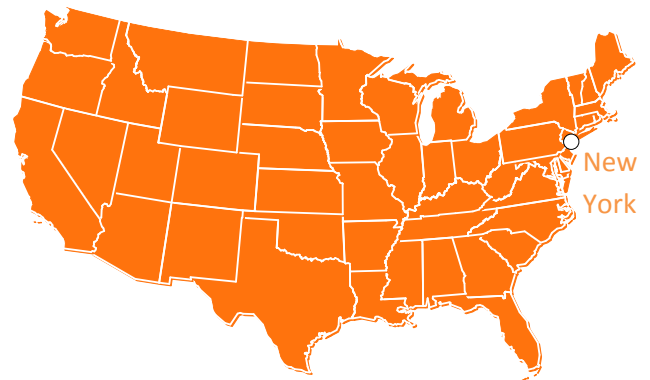


ABOUT THE CENTRE

- Beautiful, safe site located in the CW Post campus of Long Island University
- Closed campus with excellent sports facilities
- 307.9 beautiful acres in Brookville New York
- Just over an hour away from New York City
- Very close to Long Island's world-class beaches
- Free internet access (some WIFI available)



ACCOMMODATION

- Residential halls are all American style dormitories with shared rooms with shared bathrooms. (Ratio 1:6-8)
- Twin rooms (some bunk beds)
- Rooms in residence are equipped with air-conditioning



FACILITIES

- **Dining Hall:** self-service in the large, spacious food hall
- **Sports facilities:** multi-purpose sports, dance studio, football, soccer, basketball, outdoor tennis courts, Olympic size indoor swimming pool
- **Common areas:** computer lab, vending machines, cafeteria, shops, recreation areas, room for discos, etc.
- **Shops:** various small shops and cafes on campus.

INCLUDED EXCURSIONS

TRANSFERS TO/FROM CENTRE

John F. Kennedy Int'l Airport (JFK) 30-40 minutes

La Guardia Int'l Airport (LGA) 30-40 minutes

Upon arrival at the airport, students will be met by the school's driver holding an Embassy sign with the name of the student or group. Their transfer company will take the student to the LIU Residence.

LIVING ON CAMPUS

- **LAUNDRY** can be done with a card operated facility within the residence. The cost is approximately \$1.50 per wash and \$1.50 per dry. Group leaders are expected to assist their students with their laundry. Individuals will be assisted by an Embassy CES staff member where required.
- **CLEANING** of the shared areas in the residence is done daily. Students are responsible for keeping their rooms clean. There will be cleaning materials available for them to use. Linens will be changed weekly. Students will need to bring their linen to a designated area on a specified day to exchange for fresh linen.
- **TOWELS** A towel is provided for each student and is changed once a week. Students are required to bring a towel for swimming, in addition to their own toiletries.
- **A SAFE** is available on site; students should store money and valuables there. Students may access the safe at allocated times. Embassy CES cannot take any responsibility for loss of valuables not kept in the secure area/cabinet. Passports and tickets are kept in there throughout the student's stay.
- **FIRE DRILLS** take place on a regular basis and an **Incident File** is kept on site for any incidents that may arise during the summer.
- **DAMAGES** must be paid for. All rooms and common areas are regularly checked for damages, and individuals who cause damage to any property on the site will be liable for the cost of repairs. **Damage / Key Deposits** of \$100.00 (CASH ONLY) are payable by all students on arrival at the centre. This money will be returned at the end of their stay subject to any damages caused.
- **SECURITY** there is 24 hour security on site. Anyone with an emergency during the night should call the centre mobile number which will be given to all students on arrival.
- **DRUGS:** Buying, selling, or using drugs is a federal offense and is prohibited. Students violating this policy will be expelled from the residence and from their Embassy CES programme.
- **SMOKING AND ALCOHOL:** Smoking is permitted ONLY OUTSIDE the buildings. Please do not smoke in the rooms. No one under the age of 21 should be in possession of alcohol. Violation of this policy could result in your expulsion from the residence and from Embassy CES.

MEDICAL INFORMATION

If a student is sick and needs medical attention, an Embassy CES staff member will help in making appointments etc. Please note, however, that it is not customary for a doctor to visit the centre directly and any trips made to the doctor, dentist or hospital will have to be paid for by the student (including transportation where necessary). Students with a group leader must be accompanied by the group leader. Individual students will be accompanied by an Embassy CES staff member.

LOCAL TRANSPORTATION

The closest bus station is located at Brookville CW Post West entrance. The MTA Long Island Bus will take you different cities such as Glen Cove, Hicksville, Old Westbury, Greenvale, etc.

The Hicksville train station is only a few minutes ride from the campus. Taking the Long Island Rail Road at Hicksville is about 45 minutes to NY Penn Station in Midtown Manhattan. The return ticket costs \$21.50 (peak).
